Oil Futures rose during the Asian session

Oil Futures rose during the Asian session on Tuesday.

On the New York Mercantile Exchange, January Oil Futures were trading at \$69.15 per barrel at the time of writing, up 0.30%.

Previously traded at the session high of \$ per barrel. Oil was likely to find support at \$68.59 and resistance at \$71.51.

The U.S. Dollar Index Futures, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of the six major currencies, recorded a 0.36% loss, trading at \$107.15.

Elsewhere on the ICE, February Brent Crude Oil was up 0.22%, trading at \$72.64 per barrel, while the spread between Brent and WTI Oil remained at \$3.49 per barrel in the contracts.
