

**Oil futures fell during the Asian session on Thursday.**

On the New York Mercantile Exchange, March oil futures traded at \$70.69 per barrel at the time of writing, down 0.95%.

Previously, they traded at the session low of \$70.47 per barrel. Oil was likely to find support at \$70.47 and resistance at \$73.68.

The Dollar Futures Index, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of six major currencies, recorded a loss of 0.20%, trading at \$107.61.

Elsewhere on ICE, April Brent crude oil futures saw a decrease of 0.96%, trading at \$74.46 per barrel, while the spread between Brent and WTI crude stood at \$3.77 per barrel in contracts.
