

Oil futures rose during the U.S. session on Monday

On the New York Mercantile Exchange, April oil futures were trading at \$71.38 per barrel at the time of writing, up 0.95%.

Previously traded at session highs at \$ per barrel. Oil was poised to find support at \$70.15 and resistance at \$73.00.

The Dollar Futures Index, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of the six major currencies, recorded a loss of 0.03%, trading at \$106.61.

Elsewhere on the ICE, Brent crude oil for April delivery posted a gain of 0.79%, trading at \$75.33 per barrel, while the spread between Brent and WTI crude was \$3.95 per barrel in the contracts.
