## Oil Futures Rise During Asian Session

Oil futures rose during the Asian session on Thursday. On the New York Mercantile Exchange, April oil futures were trading at \$68.80 per barrel at the time of writing, up 0.26%.

Previously traded at session highs of \$XX per barrel. Oil was likely to find support at \$68.40 and resistance at \$72.77.

The Dollar Futures Index, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of the six major currencies, recorded a gain of 0.21% to trade at \$106.55.

Elsewhere on ICE, Brent crude oil for May delivery saw a gain of 0.32% trading at \$72.30 per barrel, while the spread between Brent and WTI crude stood at \$3.50 per barrel in the contracts.
