

Oil Futures rise during Asian session

Oil futures rose during the Asian session on Tuesday.

On the New York Mercantile Exchange, April oil futures were traded at \$65.96 per barrel at the time of writing, up 0.11%.

Previously, they traded at a session high of \$ per barrel. Oil was likely to find support at \$65.30 and resistance at \$68.22.

The Dollar Futures Index, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of the six major currencies, recorded losses of 0.17%, trading at \$103.78.

Elsewhere on the ICE, Brent crude for May delivery gained 0.01% to trade at \$69.29 per barrel, while the spread between Brent crude and oil was \$3.33 per barrel in the contracts.
