Oil Futures Rise During Asian Session

Oil Futures rose during the Asian session on Friday.

On the New York Mercantile Exchange, May Oil Futures were trading at \$69.93 per barrel at the time of writing, up 0.01%.

Previously traded at session highs of \$ per barrel. Oil was expected to find support at \$67.95 and resistance at \$70.22.

The Dollar Futures Index, which tracks the performance of the U.S. dollar against a basket of the six major currencies, recorded gains of 0.03%, trading at \$103.96.

Elsewhere on the ICE, June Brent Oil registered gains of 0.01%, trading at \$73.33 per barrel, while the spread between Brent Oil and Oil stood at \$3.40 per barrel in contracts.
